Directions to LaSalle University:

From The North: I-95 South to Route I-676 West (Vine Street Expressway), to Route 76 West. To continue, see directions from Route 76. **From The South:** I-95 North to Route I-676 West (Vine Street Expressway), to Route 76 West. To continue, see directions from Route 76. **From The East:** Route 42 West to Walt Whitman Bridge; from the bridge, follow Route 76 West to US 1 North (Roosevelt Expressway). To continue, see directions from Route 76. **From The West:** PA Turnpike East to Exit 326 (Route 76 East, Valley Forge). To continue, see directions from Route 76.

- **From Route 76:** Take US 1 North (Roosevelt Expressway), to Broad Street Exit (Route 611). Left on Broad Street (North), go one mile to Somerville Avenue. Left on Somerville to Ogontz Avenue. Right on Ogontz to second light (Olney Avenue). Left on Olney to the third light. On the far right of that intersection, you will see the "Shoppes at La Salle". Take a right into that parking lot and park anywhere (parking is free and unrestricted). Then, either take the shuttle bus to the center of campus, or walk 3 blocks east on Olney Ave. to the entrance of campus. The meeting is in the Dunleavy Room of the Union Building. A map of campus showing parking and the Union Building is attached.
